Do We Offer?



- * **Studio Art** – Typically taken in 9th grade
- * **Drawing** – Usually taken in 10th grade
- * **Painting** – Usually taken in 10/11/12 grade after Drawing
- * **Sculpture** – Taken anytime in 10/11/12 grade after Drawing
- * **Digital Art** – Usually taken in 12th or possibly 10/11 grade after Drawing
- * **Independent Studies** – Typically offered Senior year after other courses have been completed

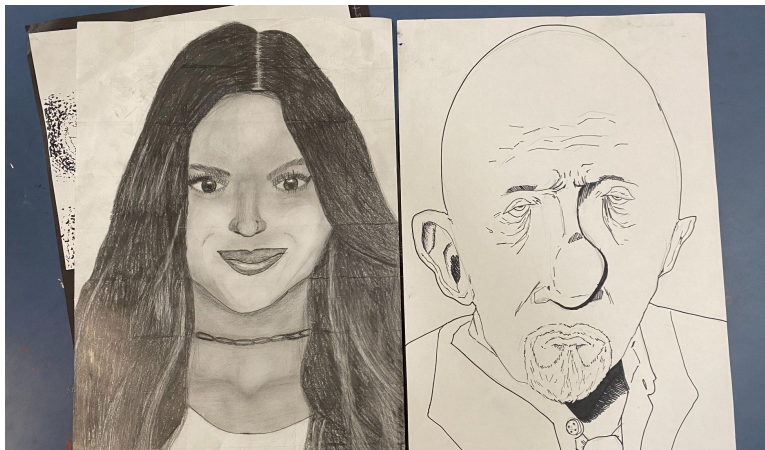
There is a lot of studio art work hanging in the hallway right now! Most of what you see on Mrs. Tabone's side of the hallway is from Studio Art

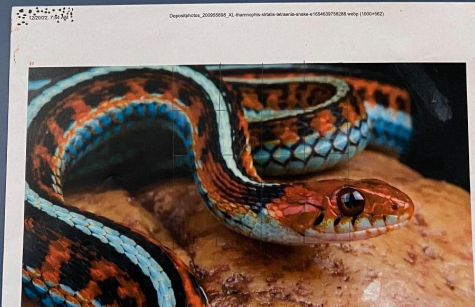
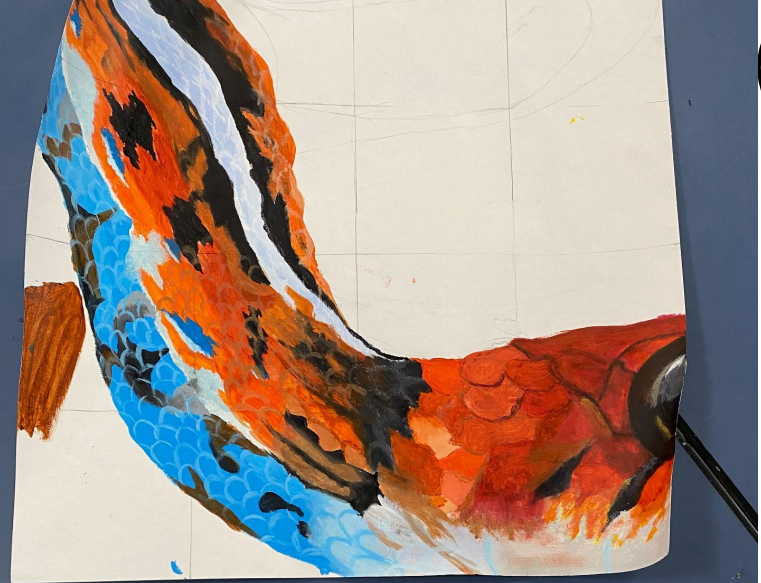


PAINTING

Painting is a course focused on learning the means to use different mediums of paint in both traditional and modern ways. Creating realistic, abstract, and conceptual paintings on paper or canvas. 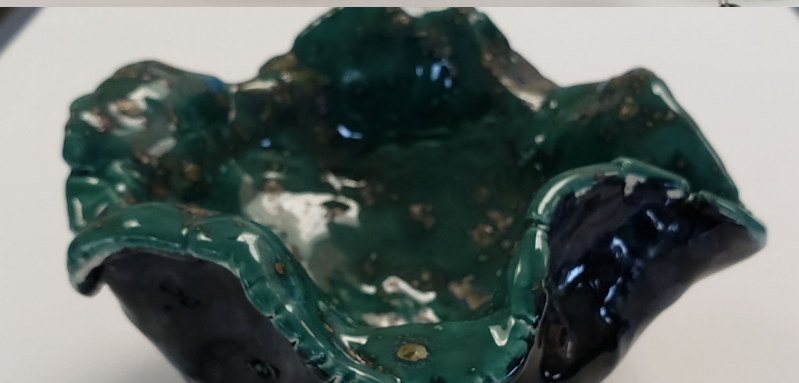
SCULPTURE



In Sculpture class students learn about different varieties of 3-Dimensional art. We have our own kiln here at the high school and spend a good portion of the year on ceramics techniques. Some years we have been able to create cast iron projects in conjunction with Buffalo State College. We use other materials such as plaster, wood, paper, cardboard, carving foam and other unconventional techniques and supplies.

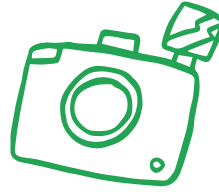
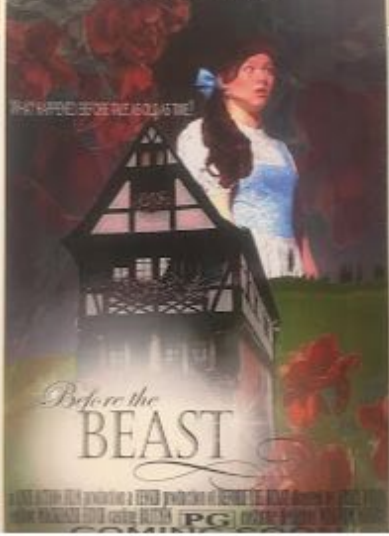
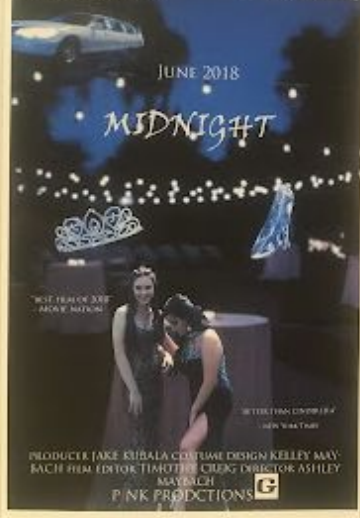
DIGITAL ART



in the New Computer Lab

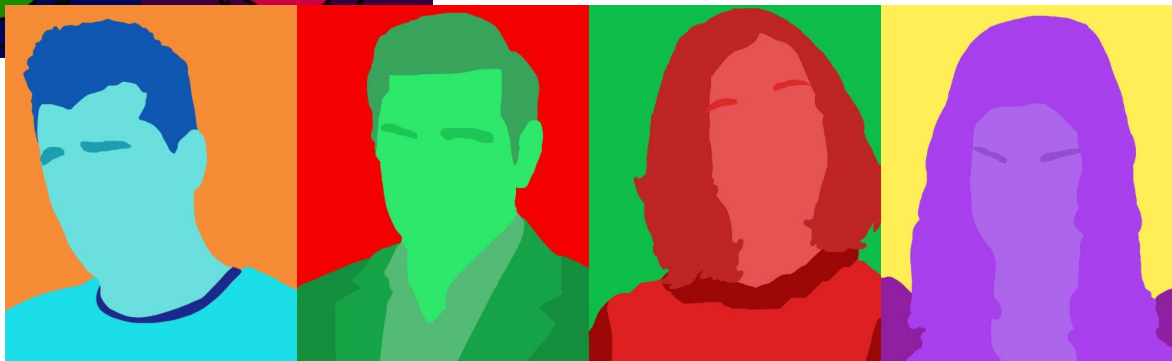
