Purpose

- The Newfane Alumni Association is proud to announce the “Be a Victor” Scholarship that will award three \$5000 scholarships to graduating seniors or Newfane Central School alumni. The scholarships will be awarded to help individuals overcome adversity on their path to pursue higher education and/or training. It is funded by Lincoln Stahl, a 1995 Newfane alumnus who faced his own challenges, including living out of his car, to become a successful businessman. Lincoln believes if given the resources, an individual can overcome obstacles to education by being a “Victor not Victim.” Victors have the same challenge as victims, but have a vision for their future, choose resilience despite obstacles, expect more from themselves, and make positive decisions to overcome obstacles they can control.

- Must be a senior or an alumnus of Newfane High School.
- Scholarship must be used to attend college or an accredited technical/trade school.
