- Staffing analysis underway; closely monitoring numbers at PreK and Kindergarten.








Newfane Sr High Branch of the Ontario Shores Credit Union Opening Soon!

 Congratulations to our students who were selected to participate in the all county NCMEA Music Festival Feb 9-10 @ Niagara Wheatfield High School.









Teacher Awarded NYS Agricultural Grant



Elementary science facilitator, Mr. Eric Schmidt, has been awarded a grant to purchase a Tower Garden aeroponic system from *New York Agriculture in the Classroom* organization. Mr. Schmidt's grant was successful (and it was a very competitive process). The organization will provide three aeroponic systems with tools to start growing in the 2024-25 school year at Newfane Early Childhood Center.

The total value of the grant is approximately \$2000.


